## Remote Learning

- Detailed schedule to follow
- Commitment by the
  - Trimester at RCES
  - Quarter at RCMS
  - Semester at RCHS
- Technology: District-owned devices available
  - iPads for K-4
  - Chromebooks for 5-12
- Instructional Model:
  - Instruction: video/digital lessons on
    - >Seesaw (K-4)
    - >Google Classroom (5-12)
    - >APEX (6-12)
  - Discussion: live virtual sessions
  - Practice: assigned work related to lesson
  - Assessment: students assessed for understanding
- Grading:
  - RCES: standards-based
  - RCMS and RCHS:
    - >1/3 discussion
    - >1/3 practice
    - >1/3 assessment

## On-Site Learning

- School Hours:
  - RCES=8:30-3:00
  - RCMS & RCHS=8:00-2:30
- Temperature Checks will occur every morning and when students are exhibiting symptoms
- Outdoor "Mask-Free" Opportunities
  - large tent rentals for classroom usage
  - PE will be held outdoors when weather permits
- Technology: all students will have access to District-owned devices
  - iPads for K-4
  - Chromebooks for 5-12
  - Devices remain at school
- Instruction: students will receive instruction from teachers & online platforms
  - Seesaw (K-4)
  - Google Classroom (5-12)
  - APEX (6-12)



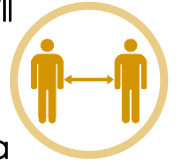
Self-Certification: Parents are responsible for keeping their child home if showing any COVID-19 symptoms
